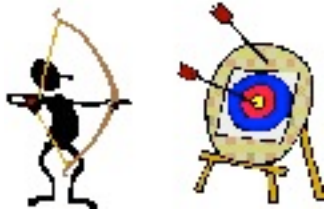


THE CLUB

- Outdoor Range with:
 - ❖ 8 practice butts - from 10 to 70 meters.
 - ❖ A 15 target 3D course.
 - ❖ A clubhouse with food and refreshments available on club days (Tue. & Wed evenings and Sunday afternoons).
- Virtually unlimited access to club facilities. The outdoor range is closed only when special events are held at Evergreen Park
- Access to “pro shop” equipment such as a bow press, scale and metal detector.
- Expertise of members who have been shooting for a number of years.
- Membership in a Provincial and National Organization providing additional insurance and a safety and competition framework.
- A safe and enjoyable environment for the whole family.

INDOOR PROGRAM

- **INDOOR SHOOT** - We are planning to host an Indoor Shoot, for members only, this year. This will be a fun shoot geared towards family participation.

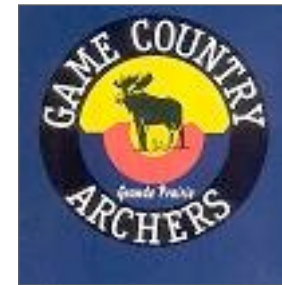

CLUB RULES

- Game Country Archery Club members only.
- Safety is of utmost importance so ensure all archers have completed shooting prior to retrieval of arrows.
- Membership tag to be displayed on bow or quiver.
- Use of facilities is completely at one's own risk.
- No hunting allowed.
- No wildfire harassment.
- No crossbows
- Please keep the range clean. Place your garbage etc. in proper receptacles.
- No ATV's, motorcycles, snow mobiles or horses allowed on course. (Except when setting up courses or doing range maintenance.
- No broadheads are to be used on club targets.
- Be considerate of other archers and retrieve arrows as quickly as possible and return behind shooting line.
- Please place any found arrows in container outside the clubhouse.
- Dogs are to be kept under control at all times.
- All Club members under the age of 14 years must be accompanied by a responsible adult.
